

- (a) There are no insane asylums and orphanages and no urgent need.
- (b) Two patients with obvious leprosy, one male of      years and one female of approximately 50 years, were committed to the leprosarium.
- (c) One leprous Chamorro, approximately 45 years of age, died, and was buried on the colony. This will be an enforced policy.
- (d) A new born arrived at the leprosary and will be removed before the 5th month, sooner if a wet nurse can be found.
- (e) One of the native houses has been tinned to replace a native leaking roof, and will serve as a catchment in providing a needed water supply.
- (f) The baby turtles brought back from the Woleai group of islands are maturing nicely as a future meat supply.
- (g) Each of the ten Yap districts will soon have provided the colony with a native constructed fish trap.
