You have already learned of your son's death through the War Department; I want to express my sympathy for you and all his loved ones in your time of sorrow. May you find in God the Father a Source of strength and comfort to heal your grief.

David's body was reverently taken to an American cemetery and given a decent Christian burial. In time the Quartermaster General (Washington, D. C.) will inform you of the grave's location, and later on this same Department will send home his personal belongings.

We of the 100th are not the same without our fallen comrades; we miss them much. But we honor them best as we carry on to bring the peace for which David and his fellow-soldiers have died.
