Subject: Nisei Veterans.

In view of the decisions recently reached with regard to the 442nd Regimental Combat Team, namely, that it should be placed in Category 3 and assigned a low priority for return to the United States and that its future assignment within the United States should be determined by a review early in 1946, I believe that no action is required on the attached paper at the present time.

It may very well be that the whole question will be academic by the time that the question of the assignment of the 442nd is up for review.
