WAR BETWEEN MEXICO AND GUATEMALA PROBABLY.

President Diaz is collecting a large army at the City of Mexico for service against Guatemala. Twelve thousand troops had arrived on April 11th, and a grand review will be held by Diaz on May 5th.

THE SUCCESSOR OF BARRIOS.

News has been received that the Congress of Guatemala merely declared General Manuel Lizandro Barrios Provisional President until a general election can be held.

GENERAL GRANT'S CONDITION.

The San Francisco Chronicle of the 12th April states: "General Grant's condition seems to be worse than it was in one respect—his inability to endure the pain of his disease without the liberal use of opiates.

AN ORDER FOR FAST CRUISERS.

PHILADELPHIA, April 11th.—An order for six fast iron cruisers of the Esmeralda pattern was received in this city Thursday.

THE NORD PREDICTS WAR BETWEEN RUSSIA AND ENGLAND.

Le Nord is regarded as a semi-official organ of the Russian Government, and this article is believed to have been inspired.

THE VEDOMOSTI SAYS: RUSSIA WOULD HAVE GREATER JUSTIFICATION IN DEMANDING THAT ENGLAND EXPLAIN HER OCCUPANCY OF QUELPAEXT.

Russia would have greater justification in demanding that England explain her occupancy of Quelpaext [the Korean island referred to in yesterday's supplement], than England has in asking Russia to explain the attack on

the highest type of war vessel that floats. It was built for Chile in England by Sir William Armstrong, and is about 4,000 tons.

WASHINGTON, April 11th.—It is stated on the authority of a naval officer that the Russian Minister to the United States has endeavored to secure the services of a naval officer here in purchasing a number of the small vessels used between San Francisco and the Sandwich Islands in the transportation of sugar.

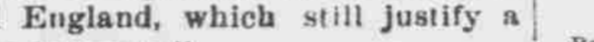

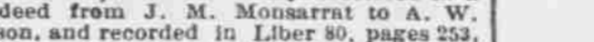
