
1. Reference is made to Routing Slip from the Office of the Assistant Secretary of War dated 20 November 1945 subject, "Liquidation of Field Photographic Branch of SSU."

2. This office concurs in the recommendations set forth in paragraph 5a of letter from the Director of SSU to the Assistant Secretary of War dated 16 November 1945, to the effect that all film presently on hand in the SSU be incorporated within the Central WD Film Library.

3. By reason of film storage vaults, currently available to the Army Pictorial Service, being taxed to capacity, receipt of SSU film would necessitate renting of one additional vault from a commercial film storage concern at a cost of approximately \$85 per month. Accordingly, it is believed to be of advantage to the Government to retain the SSU film in its present repository until such time as sufficient space may be made available within the vaults of the Army Pictorial Service. It is to be pointed out that so long as the SSU film is retained in the vaults of the Department of Agriculture, it is available in Washington without delay to the SSU or its successor agency, whereas proposed storage facilities of Army Pictorial Service or rental storage facilities are located in New York City.
