**Late Foreign News.**

Infernal machines have been ex-  
ploded in two houses in Edinburgh.  
Eight inmates were injured, and  
considerable damage was done to  
the property. One man has been  
arrested.

News has been received of the  
wreck of the Atlantic Ocean ship  
Bolkamah, 1378 tons register, owned  
by Messrs. Bates & Sons, of Liver-  
pool. Twenty lives have been lost.

Intelligence has been received of  
an immense fire which has occurred  
at Haver Hill city, Essex County,  
Massachusetts. Nearly the whole  
of the city has been destroyed, and  
damage has been done estimated at  
the value of 2,000,000 dollars.

It is reported that it is the inten-  
tion of the Chancellor of the Ex-  
chequer in making his financial  
statement to propose the abolition of  
the house tax, under which at pre-  
sent a duty of 9d in the £ is levied  
on all inhabited houses beyond the  
actual value of £20, exclusive of  
farm houses, public houses, coffee  
houses, shops, or warehouses, upon  
which the duty is 6d in the £.

In Ireland there is confident ex-  
pectation that the political situation  
will result very soon in an appeal to  
the country. In view of the antici-  
pated general election, the Home  
Rule party is making strenuous ef-  
forts to prepare for the contest.

A conspiracy was formed in Bel-  
grade, the capital of Serbia, the ob-  
ject of which was to overthrow the  
rule of Prince Milan. The con-  
spirators were discovered before  
they had been able to mature their  
plans. Several of them were arrest-  
ed by order of the Government.

Another murderous outrage has  
been committed in Ireland, a con-  
stable having been shot in Galway  
whilst engaged in the execution of  
his duty.

It is stated that Chili and Peru, as  
well as England, refuses to re-  
cognize the supremacy claimed by  
the United States on the American  
Continent.
