S. 3641: A BILL TO EXTEND THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ACT

REPORTED: August 1, 1974, Public Works (Sen. Rept. 93-1055; Report was filed late) (There were Minority and Individual Views.)

PURPOSE: Bill would extend the Economic Development Act for 3 years with a 1st year cost of \$895 million and 2nd year cost of \$945 million. There is a provision in Committee bill calling for mandatory spending for Public Works Impact Program (PWIP). Administration objects to this; an amendment will be offered striking that feature. Another amendment will be offered reducing program from 3 to 2 years (also desired by Administration).

COST: 2-year program \$1.840 billion.

H.R. 15405: DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND RELATED AGENCIES APPROPRIATIONS BILL, 1975

REPORTED: July 31, 1974, Appropriations (Sen. Rept. 93-1048)

PURPOSE: Bill appropriates \$3,390,015,000 for FY '75 for the Department of Transportation and related agencies. This is \$207,776,000 higher than House-passed bill and \$154,988,552 under the amount requested by the budget, and \$193,254,994 more than the 1974 appropriation.
