3. Present status of registration, population 8500. School children and repatriates not subject to registration approximately 2700. From this it can be predicted that 90% plus will be registered.



2. Team Capt. informed by wire that Col. Scobey, Lt. Pearce and Mr. Rowalt would arrive Greenville airport 1300. Project Director received wire same effect. Project Director arranged transportation Greenville to Relocation. Plane delayed. Arrived Greenville 1420. Arrived Relocation Center 1645. Held conferences with WRA Project Staff, C.O. Military Police Co., Army Team, Japanese American Block Managers, and Legionnaires. Reviewed forms 304A with regard to answers to questions 27 and 28 on form 304A. Departed from center approximately 2300 for McGehee, Arkansas.
3. 2nd Officer Manice Hill, WAAC, departed from center approximately 1530 having completed mission. Made no statement of opinion regarding attitude of women toward enlistment in WAAC.
4. Progress of registration good. No change in percentages of answers as reported in F.C. 19. No change in attitude towards volunteers for enlistment.

2. 2nd Officer Manice Hill, WAAC, arrived to make survey of attitude of women of military age towards enlisting in the Women's Auxiliary Army Corps. Officer reported to Capt. of Army Team and was introduced to Project Director and members of the WRA staff. All information requested was made available to 2nd Officer Hill.
3. Team Capt. phoned Lt. Jos. Hughes, Washington, D. C. and was informed of progress of compulsory registration. Lt. Hughes stated that Col. Scobey might make visit to center by plane to Greenville, Mississippi and requested transportation from there to Relocation Center.
4. Compulsory registration progress satisfactory except that 50% are qualifying answers 27 and 28 on form 304A and about 10% are answering (No) to question 28.

There is no increase in volunteers for induction.
