BY AUTHORITY. AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY WITH WHICH TO PAY INTERPRETERS IN COURTS NOT SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED FOR, AND TO DEFRAY EXPENSES OF WITNESSES IN CRIMINAL CASES IN THE SUPREME AND CIRCUIT COURTS.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE LEGISLATIVE SESSION OF THE YEAR 1892, FROM THE PUBLIC TREASURY.

SECTION 1. There shall be and there hereby is appropriated the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) from the Public Treasury for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Legislative Session of the year 1892.

First Precinct—From Hakalau Gulch to the Hamakua side of Laupahoe Gulch. Polling Place—Court House, Laupahoe.

Second Precinct—From Laupahoe Gulch to Kalapapu Gulch. Polling Place—Kaala Church. Inspectors—Wm. Henry, Chairman; N. Kekaula, S. K. Haina.

NOTICE TO MARINERS. During the process of deepening the channel at the entrance to Honolulu harbor the Dredger will be in operation night and day.

The signal consists of three red lights and a white light as in the diagram, the red lights being about 3 feet apart with the white light in the center.

All steamers crossing the bar will stop at a safe distance from the Dredger and give one blast of their whistle which will be answered by a single blast from the Dredger, to be followed by three blasts from the Dredger when the passage is clear and they can proceed.
