Finally, after eight years of work, the Domingo v. Marcos civil suit is going to trial in Seattle on October 16, 1989 - in less than three months. You made this possible by generously supporting the Committee for Justice for Domingo & Viernes (CJDV).

Now we need your help to tell the rest of the country about the wrongs that were committed, and to focus the eyes of the world on this trial for the rights of all people. We need your help to get press coverage.
