HUSBAND AND WIFE.

In our issue of the 20th ult., we called attention to the importance of legislative action on the subject of the rights of married women. We now renew the subject, and after mature reflection have embodied some suggestions as the basis of a bill, defining the rights of husband and wife, and some details of a law calculated to protect those rights.

SECTION 1. The relation of husband and wife is defined to be a civil contract, and in order to make it binding, it must be characterized by the same essential requisites to the validity of other contracts, and the consent of parties legally competent to contract is necessary.

SECTION 2. The husband is the head of the family; he may choose any reasonable place or mode of living suited to his circumstances and his wife must conform thereto.

SECTION 3. Neither husband nor wife has any interest in the property of the other, but neither can be excluded from the other's dwelling.

SECTION 4. Either husband or wife may enter into any engagement or transaction with the other, or with any other person, respecting property, which either might if unmarried; subject in transactions between themselves to the general rules which control the actions of persons occupying confidential relations with each other.

SECTION 5. All property owned by the husband before the marriage, and that acquired afterwards by gift, bequest, devise or descent, with the rents, issues and profits thereof, shall be his separate property, and he may convey the same without the wife joining in the conveyance.

SECTION 6. The mutual consent of the parties shall be a condition precedent to any agreement, such as is mentioned in the last section.

SECTION 7. A husband and wife may hold property as joint tenants, tenants in common, or as community property.

SECTION 8. All property of the wife owned by her before marriage, and that acquired afterwards by gift, bequest, devise or descent, with the rents, issues and profits thereof, shall be her separate property, and she may convey the same without the husband joining in the conveyance.
