

## NATIONAL AFFAIRS MEMO

### MISLEADING TITLE ON FOREIGN EXCESS PROPERTY BILL (HR 9996) IS CONFUSING THE ISSUE FOR SOME CONGRESSMEN

Assuming that the bill actually strengthens  
the law, they're questioning distributor  
objections to HR 9996

Many distributors have received letters from Congressmen which indicate that the Congressmen are puzzled by the distributors' concern over H. R. 9996, the bill which would amend the present law prohibiting the sale of overseas surplus on the domestic market. Apparently, the Congressmen are confused because the title of the bill reads:

"A bill to amend section 402 of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, to prescribe procedures to insure that foreign excess property which is disposed of overseas will not be imported into the United States to the injury of the economy of this country."

The body of the bill does not do what the title states. To the contrary, it would open the door to the importation of overseas surplus for sale on the domestic market. In an attempt to clarify this issue, A.E.D.'s Washington Counsel, Joe King, has sent the following telegram to members of the House Committee on Government Operations:

"Several Congressmen, in writing their constituents, seem to be under the impression that the bill H. R. 9996, now pending before the full Committee on Government Operations, would strengthen present Section 402 of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 in a manner that would keep surplus property disposed of overseas from being imported into the United States for sale on the domestic market. The confusion apparently stems from the wording of the title of the bill. The principal amendment in the bill substantially weakens the present criteria used by the Secretary of Agriculture and Secretary of Commerce to determine whether such property should be imported for sale on the domestic market. According to testimony of William A. White, Administrator, BDSA, Department of Commerce, the proposed change from the present criteria is so broad that there is serious question as to whether it can even be interpreted or applied (see next to last paragraph on page five of hearings before the subcommittee on March 1, 1960).

"The proposed change in the criteria would make the law meaningless, because the Secretary of Commerce could not determine whether the dumping of 1, 10, 50, 100 or more shiploads of overseas surplus on the domestic market would be 'injurious to the economy of this country'. Such dumpings might seriously injure the economy of a community, a state, a region, or the economy of one or more industries, even though it had an infinitesimal effect on the economy of the country as a whole.

"We feel compelled to bring this matter to your attention since so many Congressmen, on the basis of the title, have misconstrued the purpose of the bill. If you, or a member of your staff, desire any further explanation of our position on this legislation I may be reached at District 7-5814."

Because the title of the bill (which is no part of the law) has misled many Congressmen, we suggest that you again write your Congressman and suggest that he re-examine the legislation and compare the language of H. R. 9996 with the present law.

Joe King in his testimony before the Committee pointed out that under the present law the importation of overseas surplus is prohibited unless the Secretary of Commerce "determines that the importation of such property would relieve domestic shortages or otherwise be beneficial to the economy of this country". H. R. 9996 merely prohibits the importation if the Secretary of Commerce "determines that the importation of such property would be injurious to the economy of this country".

You will note that under the present law surplus property may not be imported "unless" the Secretary of Commerce determines there is a shortage or that the importation would be otherwise beneficial. Under the language of H. R. 9996 it only becomes unlawful to import such property "if" the Secretary of Commerce determines that the importation of such property would be injurious to the economy of this country. This difference is between the positive and the negative.

More important is the change in criteria which is now definite, but which would not only become indefinite but almost impossible to administer under H. R. 9996.

Although the legal distinctions are very fine, in the end it is important to you as a distributor whether this bill becomes law. A few minutes spent on a letter to your Congressman may save you many headaches as well as dollars.

Please accept my humble apologies for this belated reply to your letter of May 4, 1960 wherein you informed me of the association's adoption of a resolution requesting my opposition to the enactment of H.R. 9996. Much as I would like to keep current with my correspondence I oftentimes find my desires in this respect frustrated by the other requirements upon my office. Please be assured that any delay in my reply has been entirely unintentional.

Your letter states that H.R. 9996 " would permit importation of foreign excess property on the domestic market." A quick check by me on the intent and purpose of this Bill seems to indicate an opposite intent. According to the digest made of this Bill, it is stated that "H.R. 9996 makes it unlawful to import into this country property that has been disposed of overseas as excess where it is determined that such importation would be injurious to the economy of this country." It would seem to me, therefore, and according to this digest, that this Bill would be one you would not be opposed to. However, I will study this further keeping in mind your views and the purpose which motivated your association's adoption of the resolution.

At a recent meeting of the Equipment Distributors Association, the members passed a resolution to ask our Congressmen to express strong opposition to the enactment of Bill H. R. 9996, introduced by Congressman Dawson (D. Ill.), which would permit importation of foreign excess property on the domestic market.

This bill would materially weaken the present law controlling the importation of foreign surplus, including large amounts of construction equipment. It is the opinion of our members that enactment of legislations along the lines being proposed by the House Committee and the Department of Commerce would adversely affect our business in Hawaii.

It is a well known fact that the Hawaiian market has been flooded with domestically generated surplus since the war and we appeal to you to oppose any change in the present law that in any way might be construed as opening the door to the importation of foreign excess construction equipment for disposal on the domestic market.

It has been called to our attention that some members of the Subcommittee, who gave the green light to H. R. 9996, were perhaps under the impression that the principal recipients of any harmful effects, resulting from the relaxation of the present law are the manufacturers, who in the first instance sold their products to the Government. Also that it appears that the Committee may have been under the impression that the construction equipment dealers, like us, originally sold this construction equipment to the Government as agents or representatives of the manufacturers.


The construction equipment dealers are retailers of construction equipment and were not directly or indirectly a party to the original sales of this equipment. The Government agencies negotiated and acquired this equipment directly from the manufacturer.

The members of our Association are retailers who serve the same distributive functions as farm equipment retailers and automobile dealers in their respective industries. The direct impact of surplus sales is on the dealer who has new and used equipment for sale to the same potential customers that purchase Government surplus.

The dealers in Hawaii have been badly hurt by Government disposal in Hawaii, of surplus generated throughout the Pacific Basin. If the flow of surplus equipment is accelerated by relaxing the existing import controls it would further aggravate present market conditions.
