RULES AND REGULATIONS

- To enter costs nothing. Any girl woman or child may enter the Campaign except employees of The Hawaii Press-Hawaii Filipino News or their immediate families. Children under sixteen years of age must receive written permission from parents or legal guardian.
- Any person may nominate herself or any of their friends as candidates in the campaign. When the nomination has been accepted by the campaign department, the nomination will count 50,000 votes. Only one nomination vote will be allowed any one candidate.
- Names are not interchangeable. Should any candidate cease to be an active candidate, her votes will be automatically cancelled. No candidate's votes can be given to another.
- The campaign department reserves the right to disqualify any candidate for collusion to nullify competition, or unfair tactics which may be injurious to the campaign of other candidates.
- Candidates may enlist the help and aid of as many of their friends and relatives in their campaign as they wish.
- All subscriptions must be accompanied with cash to the full amount of the subscriptions, otherwise votes will not be issued. Checks will not count as cash until cashed.
- To remain active in the campaign a candidate must turn in to the campaign department at least two subscriptions each week.
- The campaign officially opens Saturday, September 22nd, 1945 and ends Wednesday, December 19th, 1945. The publisher reserves the right to extend the closing date one week or ten days should adverse weather conditions, etc., make such extension desirable. Notice of such extension will be given all contestants not later than Wednesday, December 5th, 1945 should this action be taken.
- To the winning candidates, the prizes will be as announced on this page.
- Every active NON-PRIZE winning candidate will receive 5% of all the money collected by them for subscriptions and turned into the campaign department, provided she has been an active competitor according to Rule 7.
- The campaign department reserves the right to increase the prize list if they wish.
- Subscriptions will count votes according to the vote schedule printed on this page. Bonus votes are according to schedule printed on this page.
- Extension subscriptions will count votes according to the vote schedule.
- The publisher and campaign manager reserves the right to hold back in reserve and use any votes as he deems necessary to promote the campaign.
- New or re-renewal subscriptions may be taken by candidates.
- The campaign will close under a sealed ballot box. At the close of each month or at any time the campaign manager will audit the votes with every candidate. At the close of the campaign on the night of December 19th, 1945, three disinterested and impartial judges will break the seal and count the votes. The decision of the judges will be final. No announcement will be made of the winner till Saturday, December 22nd, 1945.

- In all matters pertaining to the campaign the decision of the campaign manager will be final.
- The campaign department reserves the right to accept or reject nominations.
- All last minute or last day subscriptions must be AIR MAILED AND THE POSTMARK MUST BE DATED BEFORE MIDNIGHT, DECEMBER 19th, 1945 TO BE COUNTED.
