On Saturday last, Captain Mensting and officers of H. I. G. M. S. gun-boat *Albatross* had an audience of His Majesty the King at Aliolohi House, when the courtesies usual on such occasions were exchanged. His Majesty was attended by the Cabinet Ministers, Judges of the Supreme Court, Privy Counsellors and the members of his staff.

### Circuit Court, Second Judicial Circuit—December Term, 1878.

HON. LAWRENCE McCULLY, Justice of the Supreme Court, presiding; Hon. A. F. J. BAKER, Associate.  
Hon. E. E. PARSONS, Attorney General, for the Crown.  
The hearing of the roll of Foreign Jurors, only eleven responded out of twenty-two, on whom due service had been made. The Court proceeded with the trial by calling in witnesses. Of the eleven absent jurors two arrived during the first trial, having been delayed on the road, and were excused for tardiness. The Court afterwards examined the cases of the other nine with the following result: Two had removed their residence to the Island of Hawaii, and had made a timely request to one of the Justices to be put on the jury list. One wrote that he had been taken ill the previous night, and was not able to make the journey. This statement was not accompanied by the certificate of a medical man, but the Court considered that this was not always to be gotten in the country districts, and remarked that in such cases the Court would be obliged to excuse the juror, and he was accordingly excused. The remaining three were excused on personal application to the presiding Justice. One, a Māori, had sent a letter to the Court stating that from age and infirmity, he was unable to ride to Lahaina. This was known to be true, and a memorandum was filed for the Court to be put on the jury list. One wrote that he had been taken ill the previous night, and was not able to make the journey. This statement was not accompanied by the certificate of a medical man, but the Court considered that this was not always to be gotten in the country districts, and remarked that in such cases the Court would be obliged to excuse the juror, and he was accordingly excused.
