Superior Court Associate Judge Timothy H. Bellas sentenced Cabrera to 30 years, all suspended except 10 years for two counts of rape, and two counts of criminal oral copulation.

## Tenorio to order probe on Inside Edition's garment sector exposé <br> By Zaldy Dandan

GOVERNOR FroilanC. Tenorio yesterday said he will order the Labor and Immigration Department to look into "overcrowded and squalid housing conditions of

a U.S. television program.
The "Inside Edition's"episode on the "slavelike" conditions of garment workers aired yesterday on the island's two cable TV stations.
"That's supposed to be illegal," Tenorio said, referring to the overcrowding and confinement of workers shown in the "Inside Edition" episode.
"There are no excuses," he said. Asked why such housing conditions still exist despite his administration's claim that the garment industry has already been "cleaned up," Tenorio said "That's a good question. I'm going to ask (the Labor and Immigration Department) to check on this."
Lt. Gov. Jesus C. Borja, who is running against Tenorio, yesterday said there is "clearly negligence" on the part of the authori-

ties who were supposed to inspect and certify the workers' barracks. "They should look into this," he said.
The "Inside Edition" episode called the workers' barracks "shameful."

IN SAN Francisco, Barry Bonds hit a two-run homer and Kirk Rueter pitched seven strong innings as the San Francisco Giants pulled within one game of the NL West-leading Dodgers.

## Sammy's secret move

WHEN Bobby Fischer drew up his controversial 1964 list of the "10 Best Players in History," he included only one other American aside from Paul Morphy (1837-1884)-Samuel Reshevsky (1911-1994).
