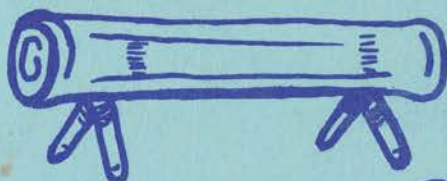

# T A L O F A - W E L C O M E

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

### Entry Requirements:

No visa is required for visits to American Samoa of 30 days or less. Those wishing to extend their stay must apply to the Attorney General or Immigration Office in Fagatogo. This may be done after the visitor arrives in the territory. U.S. citizens need only a proof of citizenship, although a passport is suggested since it will be required if the visitor wishes to see nearby Western Samoa. A passport will also expedite processing when the visitor returns to Hawaii or the mainland U.S.

### Customs

You are allowed to bring two-fifths of alcohol into the territory duty free for personal use. U.S. Citizens returning home from American Samoa are allowed one gallon of alcohol duty free and \$200.00 in duty free merchandise if least \$100.00 was obtained in American Samoa or other U.S. territory.

### Climate

American Samoa has a tropical climate, with temperatures hovering around 80° Fahrenheit year round. Pago Pago Bay area receives about 200 inches of rain per year; the heaviest rainfall occurs during the December to March period. However, even during this rainy season, there are extended periods of sunshine each day. American Samoa is cooled by southeast trades.

### Location

American Samoa is located south of the equator at 13°-15° south latitude and 171° - 173° west longitude. The 7 American Samoa Islands are the only American soil below the Equator. It lies 2,276 mi. from Honolulu, 4,150 mi. from San Francisco, 4,525 mi. from Tokyo, 4,550 mi. from Taipei, and 2,700 mi. from Sydney.

### Population

About 37,500 American Samoans including Caucasians, Chinese, Koreans, Tongans, Western Samoans, etc..

## TOUR A. CAPE TAPUTAPU TOUR (AMANAVE)

Originating at the Rainmaker, this tour takes you through 28 villages in the Western District, to Cape Taputapu, where the legend of "Lega o Taema" is found. On this tour, you will pass the T.V. studio, which houses the largest Educational Television network in the South Pacific, and a beautiful drive to Departure Bay (Fagaalu) where local fishermen depart for fishing, and L.B. Johnson Tropical Medical Center. We continue to Fatu and Futi (Two Lovers) according to legend (unusual rock formation) to Matu'u and Faganeanea where the palolo (a worm-like fish) rise from 10:30pm to past midnight and the people catch annually from October to December. Leaving the palolo area, we take a side trip to Industrial Park, Lavalava Golf Course, and a drive across the old emergency airport of WWII, past the popular sliding rock and the picturesque Vailoatai village with a lovely green and colorful ocean front. Driving along taro, breadfruit and banana plantations



with a short stop in Leone, the landing place of the Vessel, Messenger of Peace, in 1832, Captained by John Williams. A short walk to Village Paramount Chief Faiivae's Pōūno and family burial ground, see a pill box of WWII still guarding the Bay of God (Faga-o-Atua) and past the first mercantile store on the island. Tour proceeds to Amanave and turns around at its white sandy beach and goes to Pava'ia'i and its thatched roof cultural hut, past the ASG Community College (former Mormon High School) in Mapusaga, the ancient resting place of island travelers.

## TOUR B. CAPE MATATULA TOUR

Tour departs from the Rainmaker Hotel and will take you through 26 villages eastward directly to Cape Matatula. Tour goes through downtown and you will see the Museum where ladies and students are working with the art of weaving mats with pandanus leaves, Parliament (FONO), Naval Courthouse, Local Farmers' Market and Sadie's former boarding-house. Drive around Pago harbor curve then ascend to the lush greenery of Mt. Rainmaker ( Le Mafa) to get a panoramic view of the cowboy-boot shaped harbor and the lovely villages below plus an outstanding scenery of Forever green, Mt. Matafao (Needle Point Mt.). Tour proceeds to Lauli'i to take pictures of Talking Chief Pele's fale, Camel Rock, the Tumua Palace, past Avaio island beach and Auasi shore where you may watch villagers loading or unloading their goods from the boats then take off again to their village, Aunu'u 2 miles away from the main island. The road leads to Tula and turn around via Fagaitua the landing place of the legendary siamese twins, Taema and Tilafaiga, who after many long hours of paddling reached the Samoan islands where they introduced the art of tattooing to our people. We will pass the two canneries Samoa Packing and Starkist tuna canneries. Then return through Pago Pago village to the hotel.

## TOUR C. JUNGLE FISH FARM AND VILLAGE LIFE TOUR

Your tour director will take you through the suburb of Fagatogo, Utulei, Lee Auditorium, the Executive Building and Handicapped School Handicrafts Center. The road takes you on a beautiful drive along the shore to Flower Pot islands (Fatu and Futi) with its lovely legend, as well as Matu'u and Elopment cave. Leaving the panoramic sight of the coastline, the tour turns off to Malaeloa village (known for its forest home of the flying fox and the toloa bird) and where the giant hair like moss grow wild(limu). Next, tour the old Military airfield of WWII now housing the Leone Midkiff Elementary



School, Leone High School, Radic Station and village homes. Past Sliding rock, Cliff Tomb of a High Chief, Ocean front village of Vailoa with its lava rock bound coastline and large open green. We stop at the Oldest Church to enjoy the intricate ceiling and window designs. A refreshing drive down to the Jungle fish farm, breathing in the lagoon air while feeding the fish, shrimps and eels. Then walk through Princess Pulotu's garden and enjoy the birds' singing, observing the family going around in their daily chores, out-door open pit cooking, etc.. We will walk down to Punalooa to catch a glimpse of the eel and enjoy the legend of the origin of the coconut and Princess Sina and Tuna. Tour goes to Waterfall Lane and turn around at Rock bridge (papalooa) and Niuveve, the Lonely Palm (meeting place of King Tuiatua and Lady Sina, and back by way of Lagoon Park and the Comsat satellite earth station.

TOUR D. PAGO HARBOR CITY & FORBIDDEN BAY (FAGASA) 8007

The tour vacates the hotel and drives to the dock to watch the local and overseas crews at work with their fishing nets. While you're there you will have a spectacular view of the high volcanic Rainmaker Mountain (Mauga o Pico), and its unusual shape of a huge man lying down. Also you will be interested in seeing the ancient volcanic caldera that makes Pago harbor the safest and the most beautiful one in the South Pacific. We then go through the business center of town passing the Legislature building, Outdoor Local Market, Bright colored local buses line up at their terminal, and Sadie Thompson's boarding-house. Somerset Maugham depicted her "Shady Lady" in his book, RAIN. We proceed to the summit (Mafa) to the north coast of the island and enjoy Pago valley on your right and Forbidden Bay ahead of you. There is a trail that leads to Aasu, Massacre Bay where the French Captain and his twelve men were killed in 1787. Tour continues to Lauli'i the home of the TWO PELES, High Orators, then returns via Pago Park to shop at Senior Citizen handi-crafts, Hillside or Pete's variety.

## TOUR E. AOLOAU PLATEAU AND VAITOGI (TURTLE & SHARK TOUR)

The tour takes you to Pava'ia'i village to visit the original style, thatched roof, traditional village High Chief fale. From there, we will drive up to Aoloaufou-Aasufou road to the plateau where you will have a birds-eye view of the villages below, the Fogagogo beach with blowholes, airport, battlefield of Samoan and Tongan warriors of olden days. You will see beautiful, green jungle plantations of taro along the hills, coconuts, breadfruits, bananas along with hibiscus hedges. Also you will enjoy the captivating Mt. Matafao our highest, Needle Point Mt., on the island. Aoloau-Aasufou are neat, clean villages which were established during WWII. A short stop to enter High Chief Lualemana's unusually tall and round shaped guest house. Tour continues on to the Bay of gods (Ole Faga-o-Atua). We leave Leone for the magnificent Leala coastline and its colorful ocean front, then to Vaitogi the sanctuary of the Turtle and Shark. There the village chanters call for the Turtle and Shark to appear and the local legend is kept alive by their appearance. We see and enjoy watching rugged lava rock, geyser-like blowholes and colorful waves that make the tour worthwhile. Tour returns by way of Industrial and Lion Park Road.

TOUR F JEAN P. HAYDON MUSEUM & CABLE CAR RIDE  
TO THE SUMMIT OF MT. ALAVA

By cable car, you take a trip over Pago harbor taking pictures of the magnificent panorama below you. At the mountain top, you have a great scenery of the jungle clad mountains and the deep Pago harbor where both Upolu and Manu'a islands can be seen on clear days. After visiting the T.V. transmitter station, we cable car back to our starting point on Solo Hill. While there you take little climb to the gazebo to take pictures of the entrance of the harbor and the famous Mt. Pioa (Rainmaker). Next a drive to Jean P. Haydon museum to enjoy the village taupou outfit, "measina" the heirloom of the Samoan chiefs and several local oldies of the past, paintings by local artists, artifacts, weapons made from the famous secret Leone quarry and many more which explains the genuine Polynesian culture. You will observe the ladies and students weaving and tapa making by expert Adeline Huff and Mrs Mary Pritchard, ula shell making and carving. Then return to Rainmaker.

A delightful day picnic away from the hotel, Poloa village is located at the Land's End in Western District. A very remote, picturesque village set in a cove by itself. There is a small village school isolated by the beach which makes it handy for picnickers because of the facilities. On the top of Poloa overpass, you will be able to see Western Samoa on clear days.

Umu (open oven cooking) demonstration. Food cooked on hot, heated rocks for lunch is provided. Coconut tree climbing, coconut husking, and firemaking for viewing. There is ample time for swimming, snorkeling, lying in the sun or relaxing under the swaying palms.

On return we'll make a side trip to Mulinu'u peninsula for your amusement and then to the hotel.

## TOUR H. BRANCH ISLAND BOAT TOUR (AUNU'U)

Fun boat trip to Aunu'u island, we'll depart hotel around 9:00am and proceed to Auasi Beach for Aunu'u shore. The tour will take you through the town area, and on through 26 beautiful villages. Along the lovely coastline, we will pass several places such as Fagatogo Market place, Government Center, Fishermen pier, sailboats marina, Pago Stadium, Korean Restaurant, Tuna Industry Headquarters. It is an inspiring drive through the green hills and colorful waters along the way to Auasi. The tour will board the boat and sail the calm blue sea to Aunu'u, the Branch Island, about 2 miles from the main island. In Aunu'u shore, you will be helping with the umu (open pit oven) to cook chicken, fish, meat, breadfruit, taro, banana and palusami (coconut cream in taro leaves). You will then stroll around the island and hear legends about the puataunofu (pua of flowering shrubbery) see a coconut tree climbed by a man with tightly closed eyes, and the blood color lake with the quicksand. Upon return to camp, you will enjoy the tropical breeze and the warm waters for swimming and snorkeling or shelling on the sandy beach. Next spot of fun is to help yourself with the beach island lunch along with singing and dancing for everyone's enjoyment.

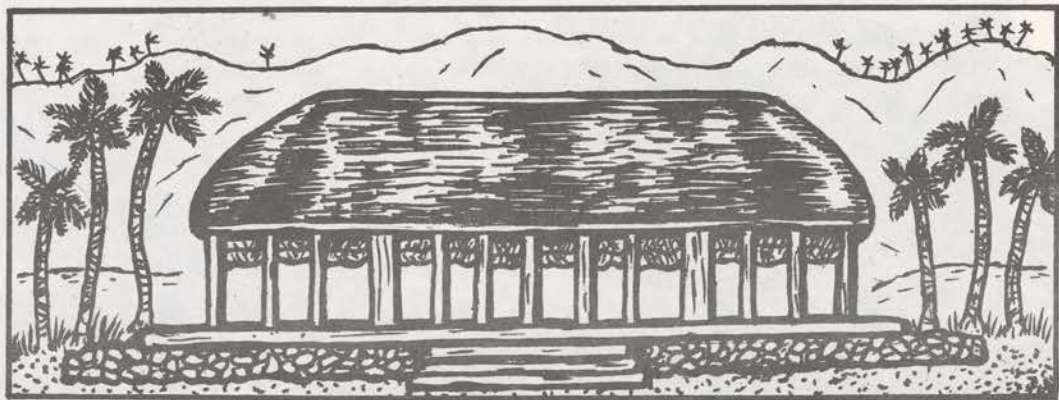
## TOUR I. SUNSET AND ISLAND FEAST IN A NATIVE FALE TOUR

An evening tour on Tutuila, at 5:30pm, we'll drive through Comsat Lion Park Lagoon Road and then take airport turnoff to Iliili-Golf Course. Driving along the road to Futiga we go thru park-like areas along the Taputimu-Leala coastline, we'll experience the brilliant sunset with its variety of colors. We follow the sinking sun to the Teal blue ocean village of Vailoatai. The next item of interest is the preparation of the "umu", an open oven, which cooks a variety of Samoan dishes all at once in, red, hot heated rocks well-covered with fresh leaves. We may roast a pig ourselves in the separate open oven if the time permits). We then proceed on our sightseeing and follow the magnificent sunset to the village shores of Amanave. On our return, we'll pay a visit to Paramount Chief Faiivae's maota where you will be greeted with fresh flower ulas and seated on a pandanus mat covered floor, and honored with a Kava Ceremony. After the Kava Ceremony, live music will serenade you while cocktails are served. Next, you will be treated with a generous island dinner with all its delicacies. It is served on traditional laulau (coconut palm woven trays). A Polynesian show will be staged while you are enjoying your meal. Visitors may volunteer to join the group in singing and dancing and have a great Tutuila evening.

At 4:00pm the host will guide you to a comfortable bus heading to the Western District and treat you to the fa'aSamoan Way of Life by taking you to the High Chief's fale to relax for a few minutes and take the time to visit a pool or to the beach for a swim. Upon return, and changed, you will observe the family rushing around getting the Kava Ceremony started for the honorable guests. The ceremonial speech given and the Kava will be served to the honored guests.

Then there will be Samoan evening service (lotu) after which a beautiful spread of an exotic island feast with drinks lie before you in the traditional mailo. Enchanting old fashioned, soft music plays to enhance your dinner while the entertainers are preparing to kick off their true Samoan welcoming.

After that, the host will guide you to an evening walk in the moonlight and telling tales of the past, while enjoying the guitarist at play. Upon return, you will enjoy tea or coffee in a peaceful evening in the village. The guest house is open and airy, therefore, you sleep under a mosquito net, just for little privacy. You will be awoken in the early morning to the crowing of the roosters and possible early riser quitar serenaders or church bells. After arising and cleaning up, you then relish a scrumptious breakfast of papaya, lady finger bananas, scrambled eggs, sausage, fried taros or breadfruits, toast, coconut jelly, juice, coffee, tea or cocoa. Next, the tour continues to Cape Tapu and summit of Poloa, Jungle fish farm, then an island barbecue on Kimbo Island surrounded by tropical flowers and various wild plants. After the barbecue, we drive back to the hotel or transfer to airport.

We drive down to Vaitogi to see the waves pound the lava cliffs and the blowholes, from which Vaitogi gets its name. Next, we witness the art of traditional Samoan tapa, and weaving, which is an old ladies' gathering to fellowship one's work. You will be greeted with flower leis as you enter the home and be given the true fa'aSamoan way that you will be cherished by all. The ladies will serve the delicious Samoan dishes after which we will start back by way of Pala Lagoon and Park.

TOUR R LOVE OF NATURE HIKING TOUR

This is the secret Leone quarry where Au-lau-mea (the iron rock) has been protected by the village people for many years. According to history, the Polynesian people used to paddle from a far to the Bay of God (Faga o Atua) just to get a piece of the iron rock to make magnificent tools. There were quite a few invaders trying to dig out the quarry for their own use, and a few managed to take some, but the guards did a good job of warding off the invaders or beggars. It has been known through years of study of the many special tools in the Polynesian islands that nothing could be found to match no where but the famous Au-lau-mea (iron rock) from the secret Leone quarry. Therefore, this is a rare treat to the hikers to have a first hand information of the quarry. You will be pleased to fulfill this adventure before leaving to hike through the jungle to Mauga Sa ridge to Lata, Utusi'a, Fuamete and thence to the main road.

NOTE: Not very many people know exactly where the secret quarry is, therefore arrangements have to be made for the expert guide to the secret Leone quarry, the home of the Au-lau-mea (Iron Rock).

## TOUR T. MEET THE BUSH DOCTOR AND HIS AITU CEREMONY

Many of the old Samoans still have a superstitious belief about the witch doctors methods of curing. There are leaves and herbs used to massage people in order to get rid of the heat in the swollen area of the body or headache. Also there are damped gunny sacks used to drive the devils (aitu) away from the sick person. They have used to drive the NIFO away from a suffering person. It is believed that the NIFO (TOOTH) belongs to a certain family. If anyone transpasses this NIFO, he or she will get hurt unless that person will get back to the family and tell the family that the boy or girl is suffering, then they will trace the whereabouts of the person to be sure that he doesn't transpass the NIFO. There are herbs and bark drinks that cure the sick from the knowledge of the Bush Doctor. The Bush Doctor will cure you in minutes if you tell him exactly what is the matter with you. No one can surpass his knowledge of the old island sickness and disease, if the modern doctor cannot cure then the family takes the patient back to the Bush Doctor. It is quite an honor for him, if he can bring that person back to good health.

Leaves and herbs may collect from his own back yard, unless it is a special forest tree.

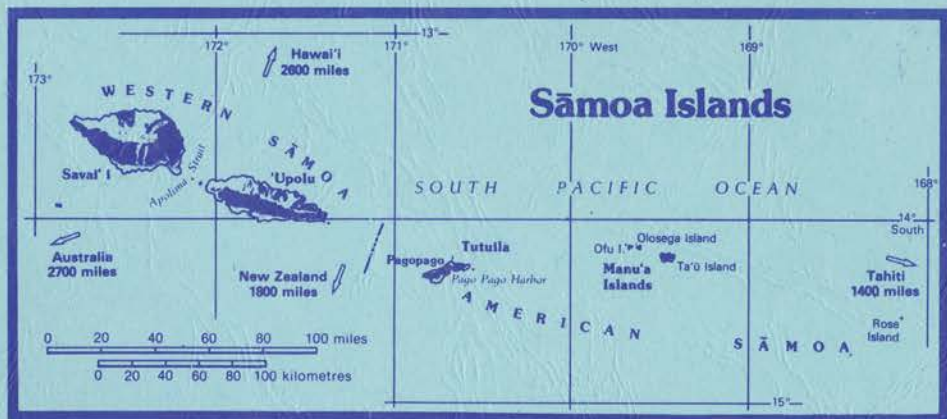
