8. Remarks, recommendations, and other additional information.

During the first half of the month while in the redeployment area and with my unit (432d AAA AW Bn) transportation was provided, although there was little work since the unit was almost depopulated. The services recorded herein were for transients rather than for any of my unit, and two of the services were on shipboard; the stockade service was at the request of the chaplain of PRTA.

On shipboard (there was no Catholic chaplain aboard) I had a Catholic officer lead the men in the recitation of the rosary; Jewish services were scheduled but there were none of that faith aboard desiring such a service. Use was made of some religious materials aboard the troop ship.

Report is submitted late because I was aboard ship from 25 August to 11 September.
