Some time after Chester Fukunaga was killed in action, one of his friends asked that in due time I send \$5.00 which he owed him to his next of kin. Enclosed is the money order as this friend requested.

I want to add a word of sympathy for you in the loss off Chester. He was given a decent burial as I remember and if you have not yet learned of the location of his grave the Quartermaster General (Washington, D. C.) will inform you in time. Also any personal effects will come to you through channels eventually.

We who live so constantly in the midst of death are learning more and more to trust in the Christ of the Resurrection. May He comfort you and Chester's friends and relatives in times of sorrow.
