The policy has continued of no gratuitous issue to individuals but there has been, as usual, a small amount of aid to schools and other district construction. This has been of minor pecuniary value and consisted mostly of scrap lumber and nails. Welfare as a whole is at a low ebb due to the lack of supplies. Not only is it impossible for the natives to buy building material but such necessities as food, cigarettes, tobacco and cloth are unobtainable.
