HAD THE CHIN YUEN.

COMMANDER OF THE CHINESE IRON CLAD AN AMERICAN.

A New York dispatch says that Commander P. N. McGiffin, who had command of the Chinese iron-clad Chin-Yuen at the battle of Yalu, has arrived there from Liverpool, and is stopping at the Astor House. The commander received a number of wounds in the fight, and is still somewhat deaf. He has a tattered uniform of the Chinese navy, which he wore on the Chin-Yuen during the naval battle.

He says that it was a stubborn fight, and was lost to the Chinese chiefly because they had no shells to use except iron ones. The Japanese were well supplied with shells, which did great execution. The Chinese shot passed through the enemy's ships without doing any great damage. The commander believes that the Chinese seamen are brave and skillful, and would make good fighters if they could only trust their leaders. The Chinese gunners fired as true as the Japanese ones, but did not do so much damage on account of the quality of the shot.
