(at large)

Thomas Kaulukukui, 67, is a former U.S. marshal and Island athlete.

He received his bachelor and master's degrees from the University of Hawaii and did graduate work at the University of Iowa and Michigan State University.

He is married with three children. He has served as a trustee for the U.S. District Court and as a member of the Hawaii Council on Crime and Delinquency.

Kaulukukui said that OHA should first serve the Hawaiian people by

making a "detailed inventory of all the physical assets of the Hawaiian people, especially an account of all the lands rightfully belonging to the Hawaiian people, all monies from reparations (if any) and all monies from public land trust and other assets."

"OHA should take its place as a contributing organization to the community as a whole," he said. "OHA should not take the position that it will and can operate independently from all other organizations in the community."
