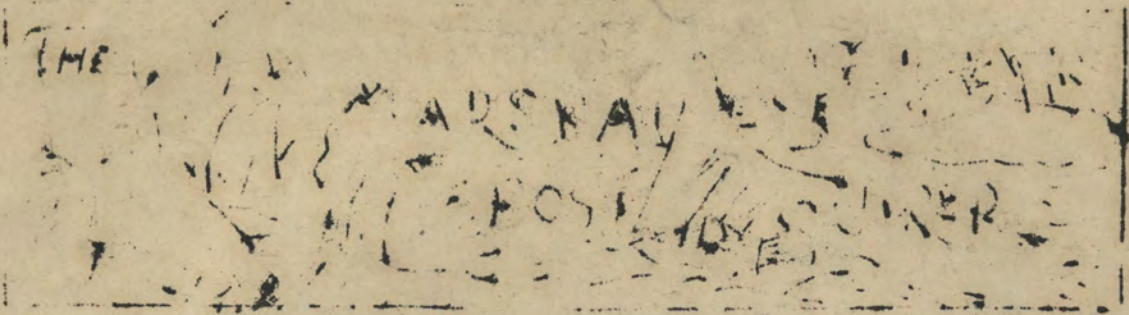

British Terms for Policing Palestine Are Reported

LONDON, April 26 (AP)—A reliable source said today Britain has informed the United States she will not consider helping police Palestine until Jews and Arabs agree to stop fighting.

Britain's mandate over the Holy Land ends May 15. Cabinet sources denied a published report that the mandate will be surrendered May 5. There are indications that Britain, if her conditions are met, would after May 15.

The conditions are based upon Britain's opposition to joining in any international decision unless it has the approval of both Jews and Arabs.

Still tentative, the conditions are reported to include:

- 1—An indefinite Arab-Jewish truce, with both sides agreeing to sanction an international police force.
- 2—Creation of a temporary trusteeship over Palestine by agreement of the Allied and associated powers of World War II—the organization which originally handed Britain the Palestine mandate. This would exclude Russia from participating in the police work.
- 3—No attempt to enforce partition at this time.
- 4—Suspension of United States pressure in behalf of Jewish immigration, pending further study of Palestine's problems.
- 5—The United States, Britain and France participating in an international force. Some "unofficial" sources have said the United States would be asked to contribute 50 per cent of the force and France 10, with Britain providing 40 per cent and the United States bearing the major part of the costs.

Britain Invites Western Union to Meet on Defense

LONDON, April 26—The British government has invited the Defense Ministers of France, Belgium, the Netherlands and Luxembourg to meet in London to discuss the joint defense program arising from the 50-year Western Union pact, it was learned tonight.

The meeting is expected to be held the latter part of this week. It will be the first convened on a military level since the pact was signed in Brussels March 17.

It is understood the object of the meeting will be to discuss a common defense scheme that could eventually be co-ordinated with an overall American-European military co-operation plan in case of war.
