Dear Mr. Wechsler:

Following your telephone conversation with Major Summers of some days ago, I wish to advise you that Mr. McGley has recommended to the Commanding General, Western Defense Command, that the portions of the individual exclusion orders relating to military areas outside the Western Defense Command should be rescinded. Both General Granert and General Pratt have concurred in this course. The details will be worked out by the two commanders concerned.

I inclose for your information a copy of a letter of January 9, 1948, from General Pratt which will give you our latest information on the progress of the individual exclusion program.
