DEATH OF A SAMOAN SURVIVOR.

Lieut. Frank Reeves Stear, a survivor from the Vandalia who went to San Francisco on the steamer Rockton, died at the Mare Island hospital from dysentery contracted at Apia, which was complicated with compound pneumonia a week before his death on June 12th. He entered the service in 1873 and was one of three officers from Samoa ordered directly to sea duty on arrival home, although the commander of the Vandalia reported them unfit for transfer owing to loss of health and clothing.

Late Foreign News.

Nine Days Later from San Francisco.

Seattle Destroyed By Fire.

On Thursday afternoon, June 8th, at 2:30 o'clock, a fire was started in Seattle, Washington State, by a careless workman overturning a glue pot in a little turning shop, which resulted in a conflagration that destroyed nine-tenths of the city. The section destroyed was on low land reclaimed from the tide, and wooden buildings were built on piles giving great advantage to the flames. The streets were paved with wood planking and the wharves extended far out into the water. All the brick buildings were costly and substantial. The area devastated comprised ninety-four acres thickly built. The boundary of the fire on the north is University street, on the west and south Seattle harbor, and on the east Second and Fourth streets. There were about five hundred wooden and fifty brick buildings. The wooden buildings were mostly old, and being in the fire limits, if they had alone burned so regret would have been felt, but every brick building in town is gone except three. One of the latter was the Boston block and another an unfinished building. Two of these survivors were much injured when the sun set that night. All the railroad property in the city was destroyed. Every bank, theater, engine house, telegraph office and newspaper office is gone. The City Hall, with records, was lost, and the big Occidental Hotel and nearly every wharf, electric light and gas works is lost, and the electric and cable road disabled.

A strong north wind was blowing when the fire started, which increased until about six, when the flames were driven at the speed of a prairie fire. The first row of buildings attacked were of wood, built on piles, and the fire devoured them with incredible speed and then reached out on all sides, licking up a big saw mill, three wooden blocks and the Frye Opera House, a four story brick. The supply of water was insufficient and the firemen were unable to accomplish anything. Half an hour after the fire started people half a mile away began to move personal effects and to blow and tear down buildings, in the hope of checking the flames, but the fire laughed at the feeble endeavors, and stopped at the water on one side and steep hills on the other. At 7 o'clock o'clock on the hills looked down on ninety acres of flames. The fire spread with the wind, leaping the streets in a second. Many of the brick blocks were four stories in height, but a few minutes sufficed for their destruction. On reaching the Whitechapel district, in South Seattle, the fire spread so rapidly that people were glad to escape with life. Little effort was made here to fight the destroyer. As soon as the citizens could rouse from their dismay a vigilance committee was formed, two companies of militia called out and 200 special police sworn in, but not too soon, for thieves were abreast of the fire pillaging stores. A jewelry store was cleaned out at one rush. Several hundred men systematically began the work of plunder, and these were reinforced by an army from Tacoma, who came by train. One firebug espied setting fire to a building was shot at repeatedly by a policeman until he was killed in his attempted hiding place.

The loss of life in the fire is estimated at twenty-five. The loss is estimated at \$15,000,000, and insurance about 25 per cent. of the whole. A number of losses were paid within two days. Offers from capitalists in other cities of money for rebuilding were received to an aggregate of \$30,000,000. At a meeting presided over by the mayor the morning after the fire, the 500 or 600 citizens assembled resolved to rebuild the city of brick and stone. The question being raised as to whether \$555 raised for the Johnstown sufferers should not be retained for home relief, a hundred voices shouted, "No, let her go!" Relief for the sufferers by the fire is generous from all sides.

OTHER INTELLIGENCE.

The United States Navy Department has decided to recognize King Mataafa's services in saving life and property at Apia, by sending him a whole boat of the latest improved model, to be built at the Mare Island navy yard. It will be accompanied with an autograph letter from President Harrison and taken to Samoa by a committee of surviving naval officers, who will probably leave California in August. Pradhan of Australia was at Montreal on the 8th inst., making inquiries about the Canadian Pacific Railroad as a mail route, on behalf of Australia. He says there is a very great feeling of annoyance in Australia against the American Government for not assisting the mail service between the two countries.
