## MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR, LEGISLATIVE AND LIAISON DIVISION:

The attached file on the subject of "Hawaiian residents serving overseas in the Army", is returned herewith for revision of the proposed reply to the Honorable Joseph R. Farrington, Delegate from Hawaii.

Your attention is directed to the enclosed memorandum for the Assistant Secretary of War, dated 18 May 1944, from the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-1, setting forth certain policies on the question of leaves and furloughs under the rotation plan as they apply to residents of Hawaii. The substance of this was communicated to Delegate Farrington, May 19th, 1944. The statements contained therein appear to be inconsistent with those which appear in the proposed reply.

The policy as stated in the proposed reply indicates that requirements for the signing of affidavits in the Theater excludes residents of Hawaii from inclusion in the policy enunciated in the memorandum from the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-1, dated 18 May 1944.

It is requested that this matter be discussed with the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-1, and that the proposed reply be revised in the light of the discussion.
