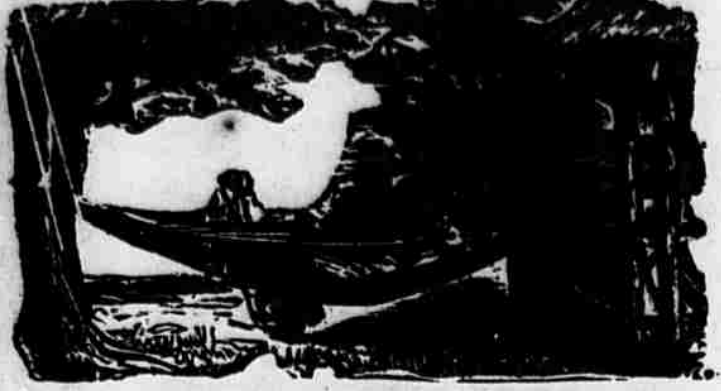

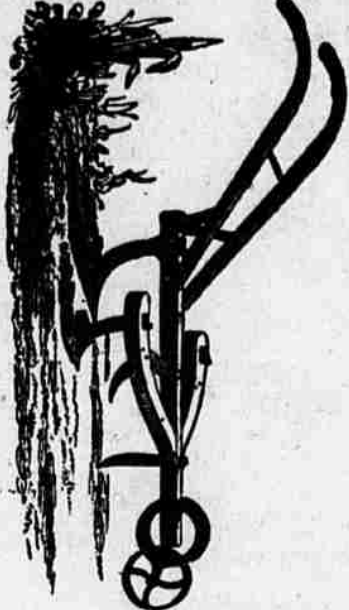

Foreign News.
 The *Home News* says that "Her Royal Highness the Princess of Wales has sent to King Kalakaua several photographs of herself and the Royal Princes as a contribution to a bazaar to be held in Honolulu in aid of the building of the Cathedral there."

TO THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY of Honolulu—For the past two years and more I have been supplying the business thoroughfares of this city with water from my Sprinkling Carts. During the dry season, when this project was first talked of, merchants complained to me of the damage done their goods, wares and merchandise by the dust and heat year after year, and solicited me to take hold of the enterprise, claiming that the Government would not make an appropriation for that object, and that it would meet with favor if some private individual would undertake it.

At an expense of a large outlay, I had two Watering Sprinklers manufactured; in the meantime I canvassed the stores, and all the merchants seemed gratified with the idea, and agreed to subscribe a fair allowance, monthly, during the dry season.

I have endeavored all along to do my duty, and have seldom received complaints, (barring occasional accidents at times,) and have had no fault to find until now. The receipts for the new season just opened show quite an objection on the part of some to contribute for this benefit; who seem to look upon it as a scheme to obtain their money for no value received. I do not solicit such patronage, and if I cannot obtain a fair compensation, (soliciting, as I do, only a small outlay from each storekeeper for services rendered) to liquidate me for my time, trouble and expenses connected with this institution, then I prefer to withdraw from further service to the public in this particular branch. I will submit a subscription document for the store-keepers and merchants consideration in a day or two, and that will decide whether or not the Sprinklers will continue to water the streets. 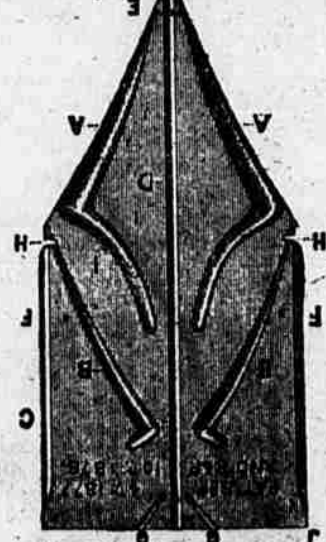

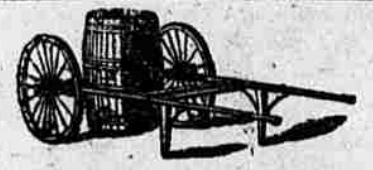
