The Insular Constabulary is headed by a Naval Officer attached to the Civil Administration Unit. A Marine Staff Sgt. reported 6 September to undertake more intensive training for patrolmen. Instruction is being given daily from 0800 to 1130 and from 1300 to 1500 in accordance with Commander Marianas letter serial 4616 dated 17 March 1947.

Members of the Insular Constabulary are assigned to each District and a Patrol Sergeant makes continual tours of these areas.

These Patrolmen in Nett District are organized into 3 platoons standing watch as follows:

1st Watch	1700 - 2100
2nd Watch	2100 - 0100
3rd Watch	0100 - 0730

Men in the first and second watches attend all training programs while those in the third watch are excused. Watches are rotated bi-monthly. It is gratifying to observe how many of those patrolmen in the 0100-0730 watch attend classes following their tour of duty so eager are they to learn.

Uniform consisting of short-sleeved khaki shirts and short khaki trousers
